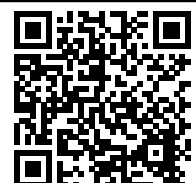
Description

Below the top are graduated drawers, all fitted with original brass swan-neck handles and escutcheons, confirming the chest's authenticity and period integrity. The chest stands on shaped bracket feet, adding to its elegant proportions and refined Georgian appearance.
