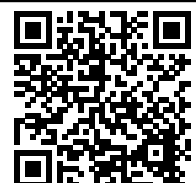
Description

19th Century Classical Engraving of John Hampden. John Hampden was an English landowner and politician whose opposition to arbitrary taxes imposed by Charles I made him a national figure. An ally of Parliamentary leader John Pym, and cousin to Oliver Cromwell, he was one of the Five Members whose attempted arrest in January 1642 sparked the First English Civil War. This engraving by W. Roffe is from the impressive statue by J H Foley which is located in the Central Lobby of the House of Commons. Original 19th Century engraving in contemporary gold frame.
