Description

This highly decorative pair of mid 19th century bronze double candlesticks is beautifully cast in solid bronze. They have very good detail and are each in the form of a medieval watchman who is modelled wearing a simple hat, robe and leggings with knee high boots. Around his waist, he has a leather belt from which hangs a bag of provisions a drinking flask and a string of game birds for his supper. The watchman is holding a decorative candle sconce in each hand which represents the lanterns that he would have been carrying. Each figure is left and right handed and raised onto an oval moulded bronze plinth which displays these interesting candlesticks to great advantage.
