A superb stem, consisting of a double merese, above an air beaded angular knop, over a basal blade knop. The domed foot is also folded and vertically rib moulded. This is a feature rich glass with the folded rim being very rare and very much there for spoon protection. Certainly, one of the best sweetmeats we have had, and a testament to Georgian era tableware. **Date & Origin** England, c1740-50.
