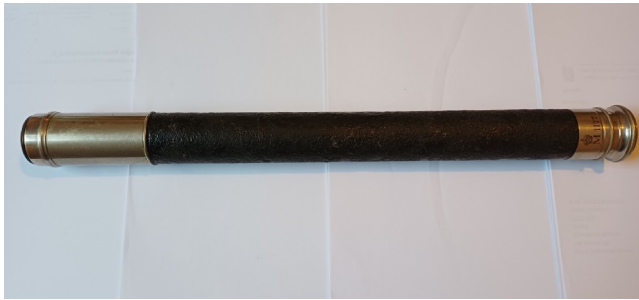

Issued for service aboard German warships, telescopes of this type were an essential tool for officers keeping vigilant watch over hostile seas during a time of global conflict. Crafted as a single-draw refractor, the telescope combines silvered nickel fittings with a leather-clad primary barrel, now displaying an attractive, time-worn patina that speaks to its age and service. The nickel surfaces retain bright, reflective tones, softened by light tarnish consistent with over a century of history. The recessed 32mm objective lens remains clear and bright, designed to offer protection while delivering reliable performance at sea. The flared eyecup, complete with a swivel dust cover, features a finely executed concentric ring finish—an elegant detail reflecting Voigtländer's precision craftsmanship. The draw tube is crisply engraved with the maker's name, Voigtländer & Soh...

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
