English, circa 1770. Condition: Overall very good, the table is in excellent condition with no damage or repairs, it stands well with no wobbling, the birdcage allows it to turn freely, the top is in good condition, and the legs are all in very good condition with no repairs to any of them. Overall the table has a pleasing appearance and colour.
