These double-sided architectural panels features intricate, almost three-dimensional carvings, with interlacing patterns and facing majestic dragons. The panels are beautifully aged and the intricate details showcase the skill of the artisan. Remarkable pieces of art with cultural richness. Condition: Some expected loss of carving and chips, with some finely executed conservation work. Some discoloration and shrinkage, but retaining original gilding with lacquered colours of green and rustic red (retaining rich gold to edge pattern).
