An "Edward Prince of Wales Royal Presentation Silver Vesta Case" by Alfred Clark, London, 1919, is a rare, high-quality silver Vesta case (match holder) made by the prestigious silversmith Alfred Clark, marked with hallmarks for London 1919, and bearing the cypher of the future Edward VIII (then Prince of Wales) as a royal presentation item. These were typically given as gifts from the Prince, often with personalized inscriptions or gift tags, indicating their significance as royal memorabilia.
