Short Summary Refined late-Victorian cabinet-scale sporting portrait by Colin Graeme (British, fl.1858–1910). Half-length paired study of a Gordon Setter and an Irish Red & White Setter; oil on Winsor & Newton board, signed and ready to hang. Full Description (A well-executed late-Victorian sporting portrait, circa 1880, by Colin Graeme. This intimate cabinet-scale study depicts a Gordon Setter and an Irish Red & White Setter in profile against a Highland moorland. Executed in oil on an original Winsor & Newton prepared board, the work demonstrates Graeme's economical composition and refined technique: warm mid-tone ground, translucent glazing to model form, directional brushwork to define coat and feathering, and selective impasto to enliven the eyes and muzzle. The restricted heads-and-shoulders format intensifies expression and working temperament while atmospheric handling of heather and distant hills situates the sitters in authentic upland shooting country.
