Description

This South-West Persian hand-knotted bag face is a striking example of traditional tribal weaving, originally made as the decorative front panel of a nomadic storage bag. Woven in wool using time-honoured techniques, it features a bold central medallion framed by geometric motifs typical of south-west Iran. Bag faces like this were created for everyday use within nomadic households and are now highly sought after as decorative textile art. Their graphic composition and rich, earthy colours make them ideal for wall display, layering over furniture, or styling as a distinctive accent in both modern and traditional interiors. Each piece is entirely hand-knotted, resulting in subtle irregularities that speak to its age, authenticity and handmade character. No two examples are the same.
