The shaped glazed door opens to a velvet-lined interior fitted with glass display shelves, ideal for the presentation of porcelain, glassware, silver or decorative objets d'art. The façade is further enriched with pierced ormolu mounts, beaded mouldings and a shaped apron, all standing on elegant cabriole legs with ormolu mounts.
