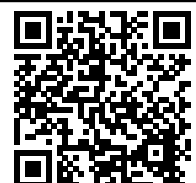

Fascinating early 18th century chest with appealing English heritage Displays a desirable aged patina, in good original order throughout Select oaks stocks present fine grain interest and warm caramel hues Ideal form for use within a bay window as a distinctive seat base Wide top opens upon pin hinges and rests upon the candle box lid The candle box to the left side a charming period feature Generous internal storage useful for blankets, cushions or other storage Fascia arranged as a trio of field panels with appealing foliate medallion in relief Carved pattern across the fascia top with a repeating oval motif Replete with cast iron lock escutcheon – untested, key absent The whole standing upon a quartet of bracket feet This is a superb antique line chest, a wonderful William III period example with fine craftsmanship and light ageing from gentle use.
