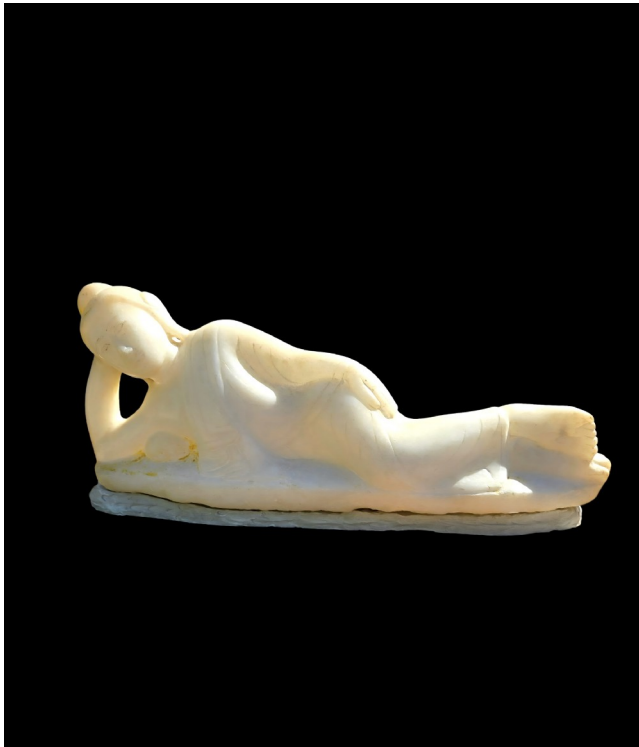

Carved from a single, solid block white marble, this is a heavy, substantial temple-grade artifact that embodies the serene aesthetic of late 19th-century Burmese art.

Artistry & Style The Pose: The Buddha is shown reclining on his right side, head supported by a high bolster. The posture is balanced and graceful, characteristic of authentic temple commissions. Facial Features: He features the classic Mandalay style—a youthful, calm countenance with a broad forehead, downcast eyes, and a serene, meditative smile. Robes & Detailing: The sanghati (robe) is carved with intricate, flowing pleats and a distinctive "V-neck" fold. Material: Carved from high-density, slightly translucent white marble. The stone has developed a beautiful, authentic grey-yellow patina consistent with over...
