Quality black leather with deep tonality and gentle weathering to the edges. Appealing portmanteau case in the classic Gladstone bag form. Dual leather handles, residing either side of the zip upon brass loops. Combined zip stay and lock mechanism to one end — key absent. Attractive gabardine check lining in good order, with two pouch pockets. Accentuated with a gold GWR monogram - Great Western Railway. This is a fascinating antique Gladstone bag, the GWR monogram suggesting it was used for carrying a railway hat and associated whistles.
