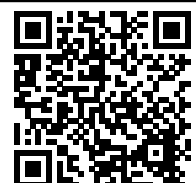

The well-carved warm gilt wood frame features elegant proportions and a decorative crest with classical motifs of flowers and a musical instrument. Principally designed as a wall-mounted mirror, these pieces were often given as wedding gifts. Overall it is in good condition with a deep aged hue to the patina. The mirror plate is a later replacement and there are some historic gilding repairs. Ideal for placing above a console or fireplace, or positioned in an entrance hall or living area.
