The base is particularly attractive, standing on boldly bobbin turned legs united by sturdy stretchers, giving excellent strength and rhythm to the design. A single drawer to the frieze provides a practical and charming feature, reinforcing the table's authenticity and everyday usability. When fully extended, the table will comfortably seat six people, making it both a historically important and genuinely usable piece of early furniture.
