The interior retains a soft historic painted finish, adding charm and practicality. The whole is raised on a purpose-made stand with square tapering legs, giving the piece a lighter and more elegant presence than floor-standing corner cupboards. A versatile and decorative piece, ideal for use in a kitchen, hallway, bathroom or boot room, and particularly well suited to country house or classic Georgian-inspired interiors.
