Each piece is extensively engraved with dense floral, foliate, and scrolling motifs that envelop the body of the glass, creating a striking interplay of light, texture, and reflection. The quality of the lead crystal is evident in its clarity, weight, and high refractive brilliance. The pitcher features a wide, stable base and an applied glass handle, demonstrating both functional strength and refined craftsmanship.
