A charming and delicately moulded 19th-century famille rose porcelain snuff bottle, expertly modelled as a recumbent lady in a pose of relaxed elegance. She is depicted resting on her elbow, dressed in a mustard-yellow tunic with floral medallions and pale blue trousers, her tiny red 'lotus shoes' a classic hallmark of Qing Dynasty aesthetic. The finely moulded snuff bottle in the shape of a recumbent figure with one hand holding a raised leg and the other arm supporting the head, with richly decorated robes, the stopper moulded as one of the feet. The figure displays a serene facial expression and a finely detailed black-glazed topknot. This piece represents the playful "novelty" style of porcelain art produced in Jingdezhen for the sophisticated collector. Dimensions: 9 cm (Length) x 5 cm (Height). Provenance: Formerly the Property of a Private French Collection formed in Hong Kong (1960s–1980s). Currently The G.S. May Esquire Private Collection. Condition Notes: * There is a chip localized glaze loss to the back of the black-glazed head/hair. Minor nicking/loss to the pink floral hair ornament on the side of the head.
