The dressing chest carcass is made in solid walnut with the drawers fronts having raised panels in sycamore with handmade brass and copper handles. Behind the two doors in the central cabinet are two lovely small inlaid drawers with a storage compartment above. Stands on stepped sledge style feet and is complete with the original large mirror that has a lovely cut in design around the edge. In superb condition throughout, a high quality design and most probably a one off, special order by Gordon Russell in the early thirties.
