Hallmarked for London, 1929, this piece seamlessly blends brilliant materials, delicate engraving, and stylish design. Its vivid apple green guilloché enamel lid, shimmering with intricate wave-patterned engine turning beneath a translucent glaze, sits atop a body of finely cut lead crystal. The lid is silver gilt on the underside, and the glass is hand-etched with floral and bow motifs - delicate, feminine, and finely executed. Measurements: Height: 1 1/2" (approx. 4cm) Width: 3" (approx. 7.5cm) Depth: 2" (approx. 5cm) Total weight: 119g In good condition – Excellent overall condition for its age.
