Standing on refined cabriole legs to the front and square supports to the rear, the dresser base has a graceful, balanced profile. The shaped apron with its central inlaid patera provides an attractive decorative flourish without overwhelming the clean Georgian lines. Remarkably, this piece has retained its presence and integrity extremely well. The craftsmanship remains evident throughout — a genuinely high-quality example that has survived in wonderful condition for its age.
