To the left of the painting, two figures can be seen having stopped for a time on a stone bridge. Underneath them, a mountain stream flows into the river Llugwy valley below as a flock of sheep take rest on the banks. In the distance beyond, the peak of Moel Siabod rises majestically above the rest of the mountain range. Moel Siabod is the tenth highest mountain in Snowdonia, North Wales. It sits above the village of Dolwyddelan to the south with Capel Curig to the north and is part of the Moelwynion mountain range. Sidney Richard Percy was born Sidney Richard Williams, on the 22 March, 1822 the fifth son of the artist Edward Williams Snr (1781-1855) and Ann Hildebrandt. His brothers Edward Charles (1807-1881), Henry John Boddington (1811-1865), George Augustus (1814-1901), Arthur Gilbert (1819-1895) and Alfred Walter Williams (1824-1905) were all artists.
