Japanese cloisonné vase, c. 1890, Meiji Period. The globular vase, well worked in silver wire, and enamel, with shield shaped panels of phoenix, between Buddhistic emblems. All on a black enamel ground. The shoulder with two large coiled dragons, on a red enamel ground, beneath a neck of further Buddhistic hanging devices. Having copper rims. Height – 12 cm, 4 3/4". Diameter — 9 cm, 3 1/2". Condition – No damage. No repair.

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
