Description

A magnificent large lacquer tray by the outstanding artist TSUISHU YOZEI XX, art name Tsuishu Toyogoro (1880 - 1952). Tsuishu was born into a family of Lacquer makers working since the 14thC. He studied under Ishikawa Komei and Satake Eiko. He exhibited at many home and overseas exhibitions including; Paris World Exposition 1900. Bronze medal. Tokyo Exposition 1907. Second prize. Noten Exhibition 1913 and many exhibitions until 1922, winning prizes at all. In 1925 he won a Grand Prix at the Great Art Deco Exposition in Paris, we believe this tray was in this exposition. This is a remarkable lacquer plaque with great depth to the carving and took great skill and knowledge, taking a long period of time to create. Contained in its original tomobako and with an image we believe was prepared for the Paris Exhibition.
