A stunning, fine and impressive 0.22 carat diamond, 18 carat yellow gold and 18 carat white gold set Royal Artillery brooch - boxed; part of our collection of regimental brooches. This stunning, fine and impressive antique brooch has been crafted in 18ct yellow gold and white gold. The brooch is ornamented with the insignia/cap badge of The Royal Artillery; The Royal Regiment of Artillery (RA) is the artillery arm of the British Army. The cap badge design is surmounted with a coronet design above the regimental motto 'Ubique'- Everywhere. The brooch is accented to the lower portion with a banner design, bearing the motto 'Quo Fas Et Gloria Ducunt' - Where Right and Glory Lead. The applied white gold setting is embellished with twenty-four pavé set Dutch cut diamonds in a wheel design, accented with a collet set mine cut diamond to the centre, totalling 0.22ct. The brooch secures with a hinged pin and clasp to the reverse. This antique regimental brooch has been independently tested using state of the art technology (Niton XL2 Analyzer) and verified as 18 carat gold; the reverse of the setting bears the 18ct gold mark (18).
