In solid stained satin birch it is adjustable to seven different elevations and the foot is also hinged to reduce its depth for use in a confined space. With label for Leveson & Sons. Leveson and Sons of 90 New Oxford St. and 21 Park Side, Knightsbridge, London were highly regarded cabinet makers trading around 1870-1915. They specialised in furniture with mechanical invention, adjustable reading tables and furniture for the war injured and disabled.
