The sides are similarly well grained oak and the piece stands on shaped bracket feet, adding to its classic early Georgian proportions. Each drawer is fitted with ornate brass drop handles and escutcheons, complementing the rich tones of the wood. The drawers run smoothly and the construction is solid, reflecting the quality craftsmanship of the period. Being of two-part construction, the chest separates for ease of transport and positioning.
