Description

A striking St Ives School oil painting of Porthmeor Beach by James Stephen Yabsley (1876–1931), founder member of the St Ives Society of Artists (STISA). Painted circa 1924 and signed lower right, it was exhibited in the March 1924 Show Day, providing early provenance. The painting captures the sweep of sand, the shifting sea, and luminous Cornish sky - hallmarks of the St Ives School's focus on light and landscape. Presented in a sympathetic gilt frame, it measures a substantial 114cm x 70cm, making it a visually impressive piece for collectors or interiors.
