Description

Tom Clough 1867-1943. Bolton born landscape artist who initially worked as a lithographic printer. He took up landscape painting in the 1880s and came to notice when his painting "Gorse Heath" was accepted by the Royal Academy in 1893. He moved in 1884 to live in Glan Conway in North Wales where he painted many of his best known works which were exhibited at the leading galleries, including 14 paintings at the Royal Academy and at the Royal Cambrian Academy where he exhibited 116 paintings. He also painted on Cornwall Devon, Northern France and Italy.

'Whitby Harbour, Yorkshire' signed watercolour, image size 35x49cms, framed size 56x71 cms. Housed in its original decorative gilt frame. In good overall condition with good colours; some minor foxing but not detracting from the overall image. Label to verso 'Whitby Harbour' probably in artists hand.
