Central Motif: The interior is decorated with two sprig-moulded fish (carp) in relief, symbolizing harmony and abundance. Exterior: The outer walls are finely carved with a traditional "lotus petal" motif, adding wonderful texture and depth to the glaze. Glaze: A thick, sea-green celadon glaze with a fine, natural crazing/crackle pattern throughout. The Foot: The unglazed foot rim has fired to a characteristic reddish-orange "burnt" tone, typical of iron-rich Longquan clay. Dimensions & Condition Diameter: 20 cm (approx. 7.8 inches).
