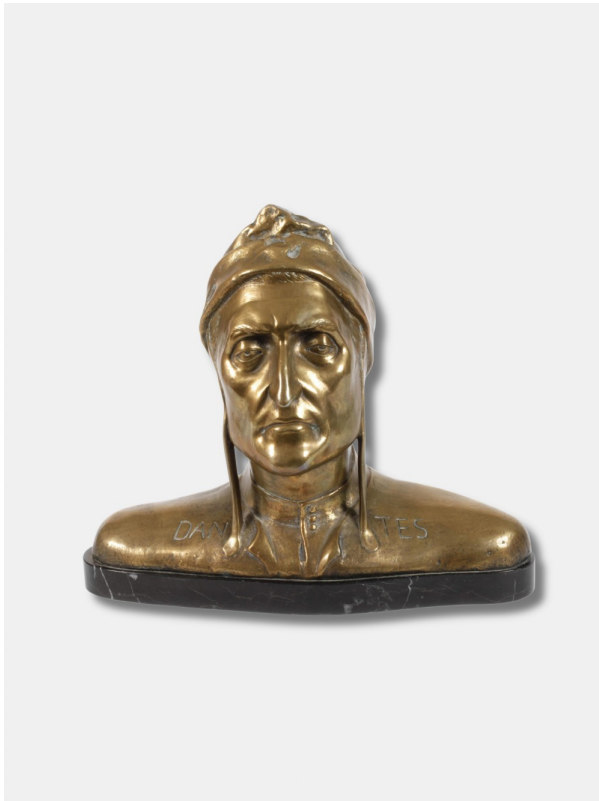

Elevated by a rustic marble base, this antique bust is a spectacular decorative piece for an interior, making a striking statement in any setting. Inscribed: DANTES

ABOUT DANTE ALIGHIERI: Dante Alighieri (1265 - 1321) (Italian: ['dante ali'gj??ri]; most likely baptized Durante di Alighiero degli Alighieri; widely known mononymously as Dante, was an Italian poet, writer, and philosopher. His Divine Comedy, originally called Comedia (modern Italian: Commedia) and later christened Divina by Giovanni Boccaccio, is widely considered one of the most important poems of the Middle Ages and the greatest literary work in the Italian language.
