They have teal-blue-hued bowls decorated with oval or 'olive' cuts above clear glass hollow stems, flute-cut from the shoulder to basil knobs. Polished pontils to the base of the feet. **Date & Origin** Val St Lambert, Belgium, c1880. Period of King Leopold II. **Condition** Excellent. No chips, cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 12.5cm Bowl Diameter: 7.5cm Foot Diameter: 7cm **Historical Context** The era was marked by the rise of the Catholic Gothic Revival in architecture and, in art, by painters focusing on domestic, genre scenes, and portraits of the bourgeoisie.

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
