Sits on a double series opaque twist stem consisting of an 11-ply spiral band outside a pair of spiral tapes. Conical foot. A very fine example. Date & Origin England, c1760. Period of George III. Condition Excellent, no chips, cracks, or restoration. Dimensions Height: 15 cm Rim diameter: 4.8 cm Foot diameter: 7 cm Historical Context Hand-blown around 10-15 years after the battle of Culloden at which time, being a Jacobite was still very much a death sentence, thus the engravings were often disguised on what we now call 'sympathy' glasses.
