Charles is listed in Loomes as 1799. Around Christmas time and the new year, a grandfather clock seems to be a very fitting sound in the new year, as it has for the last 220 years. The Case The case is in English flame mahogany with an opening front door with lots of wood inlay and Greek keyhole applied, she stands 250cm high (to the top of the hood) x 60cm widest point at the base with a depth of 28cm it is in very good original condition well waxed and loved over the years with the most stunning inlays you will ever see it is a stunning piece of furniture. It is a very nice-looking piece of furniture that would grace any home, and as I mentioned just polished. Please note the inlays that set it apart from others and scream quality.
