Opens to a fitted interior, presenting the pen tray and document slides with articulation. The pen tray lid is removable, adding further space for smaller items. Engraved with a registered design number across the leading edge of the fall. This is a superb antique stationery box, with great colour and a fascinating articulated interior.
