Type of artwork: Antique Georgian Silhouette Portrait – Henry Chichester Medium: Reverse painted silhouette on glass Subject: A finely executed antique silhouette profile portrait depicting a gentleman identified as Henry Chichester of Northover. The sitter is shown in left-facing profile with natural curly hair and a high collar with white cravat, typical of late Georgian and early 19th century portraiture. The silhouette has been carefully painted onto the reverse of the glass, creating a rich deep black profile with delicate painted highlights to the collar and hair. This technique was commonly used by professional silhouette artists during the late Georgian period. Inscription verso: Handwritten label to the reverse reads: "Henry Chichester of Northover." This appears to refer to Northover, a historic place name associated with Somerset. Approximate age of artwork: Circa 1815 – 1835 Frame: Mounted within an attractive ebonised wooden panel frame with brass oval bezel and decorative hanging mount, likely later 19th century.
