The vase is surmounted by its original high-domed cover, which features a finely sculpted and Gilded Buddhist Lion (Foo Dog) finial. The body is vibrantly decorated in the classic Famille Rose palette, featuring large, shaped "narrative reserves". These panels depict detailed "Mandarin" court scenes, including scholars, elegantly attired ladies, and attendants within architectural and garden settings. The figure painting is of superior quality, characterized by "iron-wire" thin calligraphic lines and expressive facial features. There are no visible signs of cracks, chips, or professional restoration to the body or the cover.
