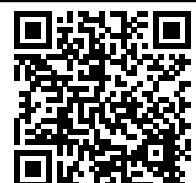

The lid is free from initials or engraving and the interior is gilded. The long and slender glass body tapers towards the bottom and fits comfortably in the hand.
