An extremely rare set of six silver teaspoons from the 18th Century and assayed in Dublin. These lovely examples are in Old English pattern and have sought after fancy backs, featuring scrolls and leaves, with additional pattern to the top front of the shanks. Most examples found are singles and assayed in London. Irish silver is sought after and therefore a complete set of fancy backs, assayed in Dublin is a rare find. Sets of spoons are getting scarce nowadays, due to the great losses caused by the unscrupulous melting of antique silver for scrap and sadly, flatware is one of it's biggest victims.
