A convex dial with 'moon' blued steel hands signed 'S Simson, Southampton'. A quality single fusee mechanism of 8-day duration. A pendulum transportation lock and the original keys to the front bezel and back door. An old repair label inside the case from Southampton. Circa 1835.
