A handsome Regency mahogany window seat or stool, dating to around 1820. The bench features elegant scrolling end supports with finely carved acanthus leaf decoration, typical of the Regency taste for classical ornament. The frame is made from rich solid mahogany, showing a warm patina. Bought from a private house sale in London's Balham. The seat is generously upholstered in a gold patterned fabric, creating a striking contrast with the darker wood. It stands on turned and reeded legs with carved detailing, giving the piece a light and refined profile. This type of seat would traditionally have been placed beneath a window in a drawing room or bedroom, serving both as seating and a decorative accent piece. The sculptural scroll ends and classical carving make it a particularly elegant example of early 19th-century English furniture. Offered in great shape.
