The teapot body is a deep cobalt blue and it has the applied spigware in a pastel blue, with an applied pale blue spout and handle. The teapot is in pristine condition, free from and restoration or conservation. Original condition. Manufactured. Dating 1901. Approx 16cm tall to tip of the lid and 22cm length from handle to tip of the spout.
