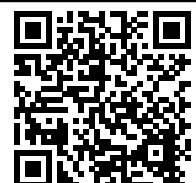
An Exceptional Early 19th Century Regency Period Gilt Wood Circular Convex Mirror, Of Rare Large Proportions, The Old Convex Mirror Plate Set Within Ebonised Reeded Slip And Gilt Moulded Frame, With Border Of Balls And Ribbon Tied Moulded Edge, Having Ebonised Carved Eagle To Foliate Carved Surmount With Chains, Balls & Carved Tassel Decoration, Flanked By Wonderful Gilded And Ebonised Egyptianesque Candle Arms To Each Side. Makers Label To Reverse - "Thomas Fentham, No 136 Strand, London". This mirror is a little larger than standard for a Regency Convex Mirror and of course its no surprise when taking into account the workshops which is was produced in that it is of exceptional quality and design. There are various old breaks, repairs and worn areas, but none out of context for what you would expect on an antique item of this considerable age and all which have been historically well repaired to blend in with the overall surface.
