Naughton was a very famous Inverness silversmith who was active between 1813 and 1857. Although this brooch has no markings its original box is stamped with 'R. NAUGHTON, JEWELLER, INVERNESS'. It is made from a collection of Scottish agates, two Cairngorm crystal and a seed pearl. It is in fantastic condition with no damage or repairs.
