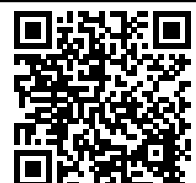
Description

George III oak dresser pot board dresser base. A superb George III oak pot board dresser base, dating to circa 1780, offering classic late 18th-century English craftsmanship combined with thoughtful and practical design features. Constructed from solid oak with a rich, warm patina, the dresser base is arranged with three drawers across the top and two smaller drawers beneath, all fitted with attractive brass swan-neck handles. The shaped apron is particularly distinctive, featuring an elegant pointed arch to the centre, adding a refined architectural element that sets this piece apart from standard examples. The base stands on turned legs united by a full-length pot board shelf, which is enhanced by panelled back boards to the rear. This clever addition allows for discreet management of modern living needs, enabling cables for table lamps or lighting to be hidden neatly behind the dresser while maintaining a clean and traditional appearance. Generous in scale and highly versatile, this dresser base works beautifully as an antique oak sideboard, console table, or kitchen dresser base, equally suited to period interiors and contemporary homes.
