The sterling silver lid is engine-turned with a finely textured ground and a plain circular reserve suitable for initials. The glass body is vertically faceted, catching light cleanly and giving the jar a crisp architectural look. This travel jar would have been a part of a top quality gentlemen's travel box. Hallmarked for London, 1866. * On a dressing table, it reads as a small luxury object rather than simple storage. Measurements: Height: 3 1/4" (approx. 8cm) Width: 2 1/2" (approx. 6.5cm) Depth: 1 5/8" (approx. 4cm) Total weight: 290g In good condition – There is light surface wear to the silver, including fine marks consistent with age and handling. The engine-turned pattern remains crisp. The hinge, screw and seal is still fully functional.
