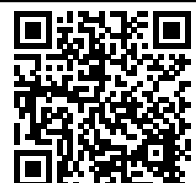
Description

John Frederick Herring Jnr British, (c1820-1907) Farmyard Scene of a figure with Horses & Ducks & Farmyard Scene with Horses & Chickens Oil on board, pair, both signed Image size: 7.5 inches x 9.5 inches (each) Size including frame: 15 inches x 17 inches (each) A lovely pair of rural farmyard scenes of horses, chickens and ducks by John Frederick Herring Jnr. The first painting shows a farmer on a grey horse standing in a pond with a bay horse by his side. As the plough team take their ease, ducks can be seen at the water's edge. The second work depicts a bay horse and a black horse standing in a farmyard. As one of the horse feeds from the ground, the other nibbles at some leaves on a branch. Meanwhile, a cockerel and some hens forage in the grass beneath the horses' feet. John Frederick Herring was born in Doncaster c1820 to the artist John Frederick Herring (1795-1865) and his wife Anna Catharina (nee Harris) and was baptised on 2 May, 1821. There is some confusion about the date of his birth due to an earlier birth record existing for 21 June, 1815. To complicate matters further, all of the census records indicate he was born in 1816.
