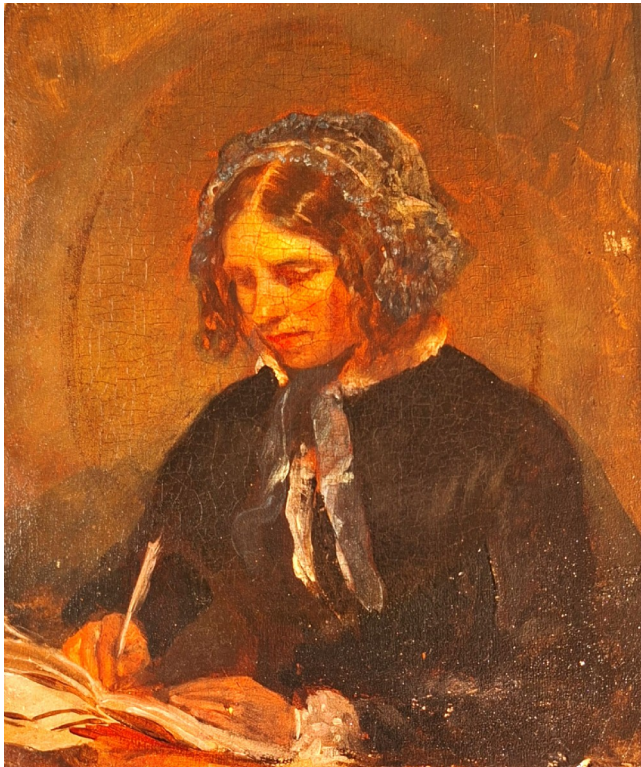

William Henry Knight RA 1823-1863 Portrait of Mary Sherborn, Nee Brance 1801-1886 writing at her desk extensively inscribed on the reverse " Mrs C Sherborn/by W H Knight/ Mary Brance 1801-1886/mother of C W Sherborn" oil on panel 16.5 x 16 cm Mary Brance, married Charles Sherborn, an upholsterer; their son was Charles William Sherborn, RE (14 June 1831 – 10 February 1912) who was an English engraver, who chiefly made bookplates. He has been hailed as having led the revival in copper-engraved bookplates, and came to be called the "Victorian little master". Artist biography William Henry Knight (26 September 1823 – 31 July 1863) was an English portrait and genre painter. Knight was born in Newbury, Berkshire where his father, John Knight, was a schoolmaster. He was to become a solicitor, but gave up his law studies after two of his paintings were accepted by the annual exhibition of the Society of British Artists. He moved to London in 1855, taking lodgings in Kennington Road, Lambeth, and supporting himself by drawing crayon portraits while studying in the British Museum and in the schools of the Royal Academy.
