Description

A finely executed early 19th-century oil on canvas depicting hanging game, painted in the circle of Benjamin Blake. This subject was a well-established favourite of Blake, who was known for supplying sporting and still life works to wealthy landowning patrons of the period. Paintings of this type were often intended for country houses, where they added both atmosphere and a sense of tradition to interior spaces. Dating to around 1810, the work shows a clear affinity with Blake's style, particularly in the confident handling of the paint and the careful attention to texture and detail. The composition is both balanced and naturalistic, with a pleasing richness to the palette. Examples of Blake's work can be found in major public collections, including the Victoria and Albert Museum and the Tate, as well as in numerous private and country house collections. The painting presents well, with strong colour and a lively surface, making it an attractive piece both as a period work and as a decorative interior accent.
